Each 3 day parcel comprises basic food items sufficient for the size of the household, plus essential hygiene items and supplies for young babies too. The food is donated by members of the public, companies and leading supermarkets, although to ensure we have everything on our shelves, we do have to purchase some items from our own funds too.

With a support network of almost 100 volunteers, Stockport Foodbank

- currently runs 7 Foodbank centres across the town bringing much needed support to many hundreds of households, six days a week.

- distributes over 80,000 meals every year
