2019 saw a record number of donations to Stockport Foodbank culminating with overwhelming support for our Reverse Advent campaign.

Our foodbank centres are funded entirely by voluntary donations as we do not receive grants or funding from the Government or local council. We were therefore delighted that so many individuals, organisations, companies, churches, schools and other community groups
